(The Conversion of Saul)

1.Saul's Night 9:1-2

>**1 Tim 1:15** This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

>**Rom 3:10** As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

>**Rom 3:23** For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

1.Saul's Night 9:1-2

>Jn 1:5 And the light shineth in darkness;
and the darkness comprehended it not

>Jn 12:46 I am come a light into the world,
that whosoever believeth on me should
not abide in darkness

>2 Cor 4:4 In whom the god of this world
hath blinded the minds of them which
believe not, lest the light of the glorious
gospel of Christ, who is the image of God,
should shine unto them.

1.Saul's Night 9:1-2

>**Jn 3:19** And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

>**Eph 5:8** For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

>**1 Peter 2:9** ...who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light;

2. Saul's Light 9:3-8

> **2 Cor 4:6** For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

> **1 Jn 1:5-6** This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:
